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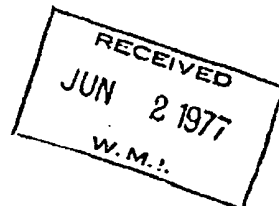

The enclosed is a copy of the text which Harvard SPH will present at the American Industrial Hygiene meeting on May 26th.

You will note that they have deleted reference to trace metals and the single fiber of chrysotile previously reported. They have also reported that the NIOSH/USPHS method for counting fibers is invalid for a talc environment.
