I. Polyurethane Area

- A) Spray Booth
Two workers spraying asbestos board. One with SMA mask around neck the other no mask at all.

II. Maintenance Area:

- A) Worker cleaning machinery with S49 Spray (A volatile calcinated solvent) not wearing mask, in fact, no mask at all.
- B) This area has received a thorough house cleaning and the machinery painted. There is great improvement in this area.

III. Asbestos Area:

- A) Fork lift operators, no masks.
- B) Worker cleaning Asbestos Board press-no mask at all.
- C) Sheet metal worker constructing new Air ducts, high over asbestos area, no masks. These fellows are getting plenty of asbestos for their lungs to chew on!
- D) New asbestos assembly line is progressing well and this area continues to make the plant a cheerful, clean, and pleasant place to work.
- E) Mens lavatory and wash room is very clean and neat. The maintenance worker here should be complimented.
- F) Womens lavatory and wash room will soon be completely renovated and it surely does need this.
